



# CERTIFICATE II IN SECURITY OPERATIONS

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Students must be over 18 years of age before commencing studies.(It is a licensing requirement)
- Person must not have been convicted of a disqualifying offence in the last 10 years

### Licensing Requirements

Legislation in Queensland requires persons working as a security provider to be licensed. The office of Fair Trading administers and issues licenses to successful applicants. Successful completion of CPP20218 Certificate II in Security Operations is a mandatory requirement for licensing.

There are no pre-requisites preventing anyone from completing the program for educational purposes, however under the Security Providers Act a person must be an " Appropriate Person" to obtain a license. A person must NOT be an appropriate person if they are convicted of a disqualifying offence under Section 3 of the provisions of the Criminal Code; A patient within the meaning of the Mental Health Act; Taken advantage as a debtor, of the laws of Bankruptcy; or have been charged or convicted of an indictable offence.

## STUDY PATHWAY AND CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

### Pathways into the qualification:

Preferred pathways for candidates considering this qualification include:

- Certificate III in Security Operations

After successful completion of CPP Certificate in security operations:

successful graduates will receive a CPP Certificate in security operations

Learners may complete individual units of competency and receive a statement of attainments for that unit.

- Security Officer-Unarmed guard
- Security Officer-Crowd controller
- Control room operations

# Certificate II in Security Operations

## RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL)

RPL is the assessment process for recognizing competencies gained through previous learning, work and life experiences. Students who have completed any of the subjects or have practical experience that can be used for RPL, can contact NYC prior to enrolment. In order to be granted RPL, candidates are required to provide evidence that they are already competent in the specific subject/ subjects and these evidences should be valid, authentic, current and sufficient.
